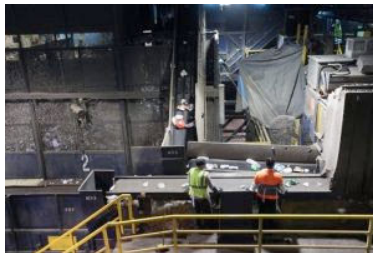
Montgomery County, MD Considering Building New Recycling Center, Adding Robots

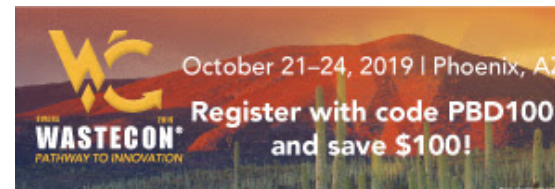
