Further it is to submit that Special Drive of Sanitation is being taken for Cleaning of Drains, Sweeping of Roads, Lifting of Garbage, Anti Larval Measures, Door to Door Garbage Collection and Removal Unwanted Plants in the entire town from 29-07-2013 to 08-08-2013(Copy Enclosed).

- One Vehicle has been engaged in all Zones in view of Ramzan Month for Lifting of Garbage.
- Anti Mosquito Measures has been taken by spraying of larvi cidel drugs and also releasing of oil balls wherever water stagnated in the open spaces.
- Desiltation of Drains is being done in 1st phase out of 568Kms of Strom Water Drains, Internal Drains, 438Kms of Strom Water Drains has been desilted and 2nd phase is under progress for desiltation of remaining Storm Water Drains i.e., 130Kms which will be completed within a week.
- Catching of Dogs is being done in some areas of the town and 350 Dogs and sofar 286 Dogs has been catched and released for away from the town.

It is to submit that this Corporation is being supplying of Drinking Water 45.70MLD per day through 3Nos Sources i.e., Alisagar, Manchippa and Rathunath Tank and following are the present levels.
